Judges regarding the observance of drivers on track in Suzuka Circuit General Sporting Regulations Article 24 and the act of obstruction in Article 25.
- 2) Start judge: Judges regarding the jump start in Suzuka Circuit General Sporting Regulations Article 34.
- 3) Judge of Fact (Pit): Judges regarding the pit work in Suzuka Circuit General Sporting Regulations Article 38.
- 4) Finish Judge: Judges regarding the finish of race and its classification in Suzuka Circuit General Sporting Regulations Article 42.
No protest against the judges for above 1), 2), 3) and 4) shall be admitted in accordance with the FIA International Sporting Code Article 13.6.
