

## About the cancellation of the 2020 49th Summer Endurance "BH Auction SMBC Suzuka 10 Hours Endurance Race"

Mobilityland Corporation announces the cancellation of the 2020 49th Summer Endurance "BH Auction SMBC Suzuka 10 Hours Endurance Race" which was originally scheduled to be held at Suzuka Circuit from August 20th (Thur.) to 23rd (Sun.) 2020.

In light of present circumstances, including the preventive measures involving the coronavirus (COVID-19) being enacted in Japan and overseas, we have carefully studied the situation and made the decision to cancel the race. This decision is based on the characteristics of this race event and the fact that many of the participating teams are conducting their racing activities globally at venues in places such as the countries of Europe and other Asian countries, as well as the fact that this race was also to be held as a round of the Intercontinental GT Challenge powered by Pirelli (IntGTC) series.

With this cancellation, the "Suzuka Motorsports Festival" (Organizer: the City of Suzuka), featuring several attractions including the parade run on public roads with cars participating in the SUZUKA 10H, which was scheduled to be held on August 20th (Thur.), will also be cancelled.

We extend our apologies and regrets to all the fans who were looking forward to attending the SUZUKA 10H and all of the other stakeholders involved in this race event and ask for your kind understanding regarding this unavoidable cancellation.

## **Kaoru Tanaka, President Representative Director of Mobilityland Corporation:**

"We have decided to cancel the BH Auction SMBC Suzuka 10 Hours Endurance Race in light of the nature of this race event with many participant teams coming from Europe and other countries around the world. The parade of the cars participating in the SUZUKA 10H on the public roads, which was held by the City of Suzuka for the first time last year as a historic first step, will also be cancelled. We want to express our regrets to all the fans who were looking forward to attending the SUZUKA 10H and all of the other stakeholders involved in this race event and ask for a kind understanding regarding this unavoidable cancellation."
